Hotel Accommodations

All rooms have one king bed or 2 queen beds and feature a beautiful wood armoire and 20" television equipped with basic network television, pay-per-view movies and video checkout. Telephones are equipped with a data port for laptop Internet access and most rooms can access wireless Internet network. Each room includes an alarm clock, coffee maker, hair dryer, iron/ironing board, blackout curtains, shower/tub combination, an individual climate-controlled heating and air conditioning unit and writing table with chairs. 24-hour room service is also available for your dining needs.

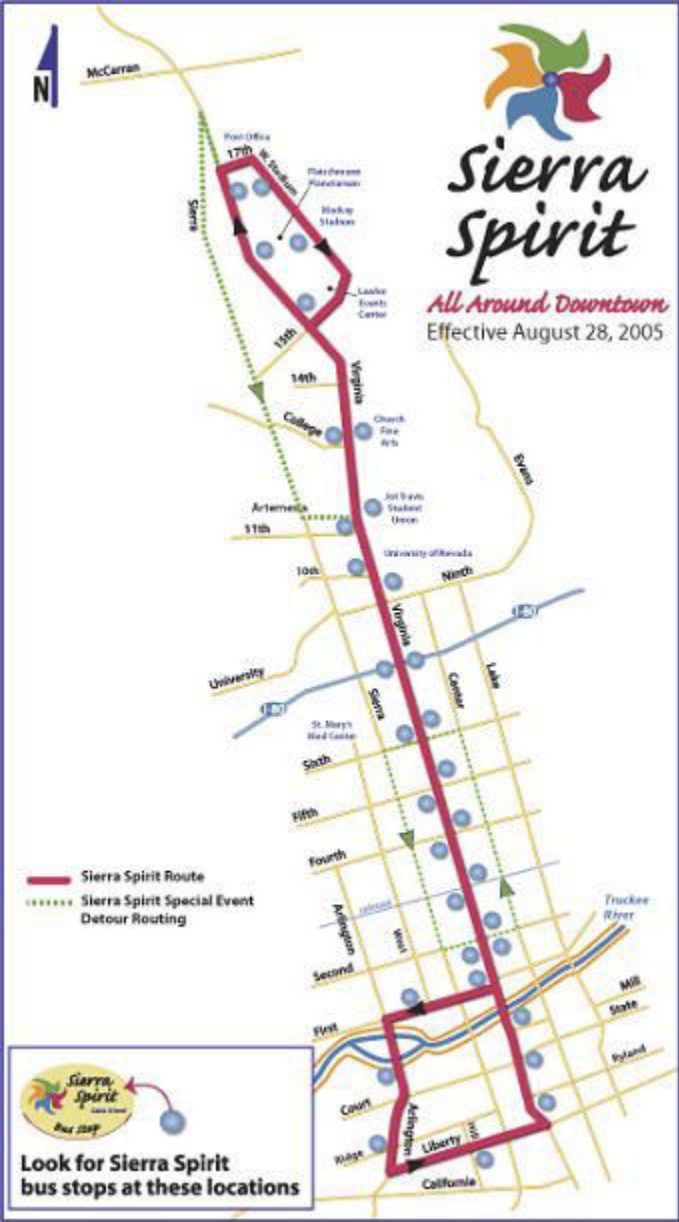

Places to Go

[Wild Island Family Adventure Park](#)

With a water park, go-karts, mini-golf and bowling at Wild Island there is something fun for everyone.

[Ultimate Rush Thrill Park](#)

The planetarium offers public star shows and large-format films showing daily in the dome theater, and public star observing courtesy of the Astronomical Society of Nevada. It was built in 1964 and originally called the "Fleischmann Atmospherium-Planetarium."

[Animal Ark Wildlife Sanctuary](#)

Animal Ark is a 38-acre wildlife sanctuary and nature center northwest of Reno, Nevada. This facility's rural setting provides an ideal place to house non-releasable wildlife and allows the public a unique opportunity to view these animals in natural habitat exhibits through glass viewing areas.

Sierra Safari Zoo is Nevada's largest zoo and the only zoo in Northern Nevada. It houses dozens of animals, from cats to sloths, marsupials, rodents, small mammals and hoof stock. It is located in northern Reno.
