



2012 APPLICATION OVERVIEW & CHECKLIST

The following has been prepared to assist in ensuring the 2012 Davidson THINK Summer Institute Application Form is complete prior to submission.

Eligibility

In order to be eligible, applicant must:

- be 13 to 16 years of age during THINK.
- be a U.S. citizen or permanent U.S. resident living in the United States.
- commit to being a full-time residential student from July 14 thru August 4, which does not allow absences.
- meet or exceed the designated scores on the SAT and/or ACT.
- receive positive nominations from one individual as specified in the application.
- NOT have a history of demonstrating or threatening violence, harm, or other behavior that is grossly inappropriate toward any other person, or to himself or herself, or that otherwise indicates violent tendencies or other disturbing behaviors.
- have a complete 2012 Application Form and 2012 Nomination Form by *March 1, 2012 (**please note due to limited space availability, it is highly encouraged to submit an application before the deadline*).

Application Procedure and Checklist

The following items must be completed and submitted to the Davidson THINK Summer Institute:

- Section One: Applicant Information
- Section Two: Course Selections
 - *If you select STATISTICS 152 or PHYSICS 293 please note prerequisite requirements.*
- Section Three: Program Eligibility
 - *A copy of an official SAT and/or ACT score report must be attached to the application.*
- Section Four: Nominator List and Form for New Applicants
 - *Applicants must submit one [nominator form](#). Forms arriving before application will be kept on file.*
- Section Five: Program Fees
 - *\$50 non-refundable application fee is due upon application submission.*
 - *If applicable to your family, the [Financial Assistance Application](#) is due upon program application submission.*
- Section Six: Important Date Acknowledgement
- Section Seven: Agreement

Application Policy

Applications are considered on a first-come, first-served basis. Applications for the 2012 program are available now and will remain open until 60 highly qualified students are accepted. Due to this limited space availability, it is strongly recommended to apply *before* March 1, 2012. Please check test dates for the [SAT](#) and/or [ACT](#) to ensure plenty of time to receive score report(s) prior to applying to THINK.

Notification Policy

Applicants will receive acceptance notification within one month of application submission/completion.

Tuition Policy

Tuition of \$3,000 covers course credits, room, board, textbooks and class materials, and the cost of planned program activities. *All fees are non-refundable*. Additionally, participants are responsible for transportation to and from the program, and spending money.
